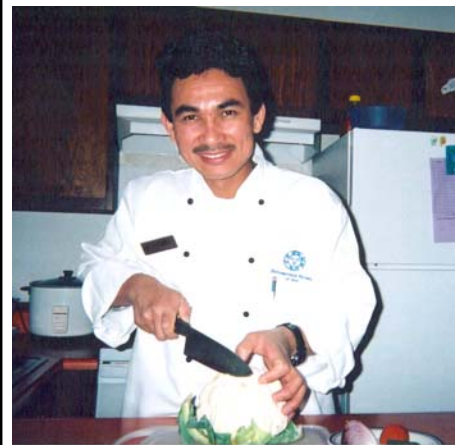


In heartfelt memory:
