Stop getting mad at crazy people on the mountain. Not drop anymore IPODS off the chairlift. And, drink more high-end beverages and fewer low-end ones.

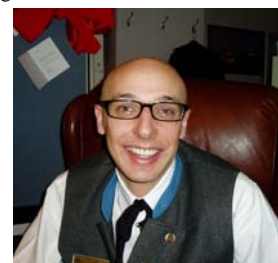
Stop making jokes about the American soccer team. But I won't be able to fulfill this promise with the World Cup coming up.
